Qualifications for SASSI Purchase

The SASSI-4, SASSI-A2, Spanish SASSI, SAS-ASL and SAVR-S2 are carefully developed screening instruments that require proper administration, scoring, and interpretation. Therefore, eligibility to purchase, administer and/or use these measures for clinical purposes is limited to individuals with training and experience in the area of assessment and should be used by:

Human service practitioners whose certification and/or professional training includes assessment (e.g., psychologists, social workers, certified addictions counselors)

or

Individuals who have completed SASSI training that was presented by a certified SASSI trainer.

Individuals who do not have professional training can administer and score the instruments if there is appropriate supervision.

It is suggested that you contact your state or provincial government for specific information on the laws regulating assessment and testing in your area.

Qualifications for BADDS Purchase

A bachelor's degree in psychology or a related discipline (e.g. counseling, education, human resources, social work, criminal justice, etc.) and coursework related to psychological testing,

or

Professional membership in an organization that requires training and experience in the use of psychological assessments and surveys,

or

Individuals who have completed BADDS training online.

Please note: If you do not meet the above criteria, but are supervised by someone who does, you may still use the BADDS. However, the Qualification Form must be completed by the qualifying individual.
